Audiences are starved to see new possibilities, new role models of ourselves, new ways of being and new sustainable technologies that solve the most pressing and urgent problems we face as a global species today. We crave to see a future in which humanity learns to live in harmony with the natural world and with each other.

This is why we wrote the short film 'Our Journey', as a first stepping stone in our long-term mission.



FILM SUMMARY

David and his daughter Jane drive through a desolate landscape. The setting, which first seems post-apocalyptic, reveals a utopian society utilizing **real-world technologies that are being developed right now*** like compostable batteries, innovative bricks made of alternative low-impact materials and even biological cells to repair environmental damage.

Inspired by Solar Punk, the project envisions a future where humans and nature coexist sustainably. At first glance the barren and overgrown landscapes present the world as a dystopia. The technologies that our protagonists use and discuss on their journey are so advanced that their use is counterintuitive. What would you think if you saw someone throwing a battery outside of their car window?



The story aims to raise awareness about current sustainable technologies and how their practical use helps us imagine a future where humanity actively works and manages to restore the planet.


In stark contrast with David's cynicism is his daughter Jane's hope, emphasizing generational responsibility and **embodying new attitudes and perspectives** towards the natural world and humanity.



David and his daughter Jane travel through a desolate landscape, their world seemingly ravaged by humanity's mistakes. David, weighed down by guilt and regret, sees little hope in the future, while Jane, full of optimism, believes in the possibility of change.

As they move through this broken world, it becomes clear that it isn't a dystopia. What seems like destruction is actually a world on the mend—powered by technologies that feel counterintuitive. This world is treated with apparent nonchalance, as actions that would harm the environment in our time, here are done casually. Compostable batteries, biofuel cells, and other sustainable innovations are quietly rebuilding the planet, bringing to life the future David had given up on. Through Jane's eyes, we see that hope is found in action, innovation, and the human capacity to repair damage.

The film contrasts the conventional precautionary tales of dystopia and despair with optimism, revealing that even in the darkest times, there is a path to redemption if we choose to take it.



David

A rugged and thoughtful man in his late 40s, David bears the weight of his past decisions and the burden of guilt for humanity's impact on the environment. His serious demeanor hides a deep concern for the future, yet beneath his cynicism lies a flicker of hope, especially when he sees the potential for change through his daughter's optimism. He embodies the struggle between despair and the desire to repair the world.

Jane

A spirited and imaginative girl around 15 years old, Jane radiates positivity and hope. With her bright smile and a curiosity for the world, she believes in the possibility of a better future. Jane is deeply connected to nature, finding joy in nurturing the environment. Her youthful enthusiasm challenges her father's pessimism, showcasing the potential of the new generation to inspire change and healing.






